

Recommended PPE for Healthcare Settings:

Sessional/extended use of facemasks apply across Jersey for HCWs in any health or other care settings

***Suspected** = awaiting symptomatic test result.
Does not equal routine surveillance result

****Low risk:**

- a) Patient is not known or suspected COVID-19
OR
- b) Had a negative SARS-CoV-2 PCR test within 72 hours of treatment and for planned admissions, have self-isolated for the required period
OR
- c) Individuals who have recovered from COVID-19 and have clinically improved and had at least 48 hours without fever (without the use of medication)
- d) Within primary and secondary care where routine surveillance takes place

All staff, visitors and outpatients are required to wear facemasks within the health care environment

Office workers: Non-clinical staff working in a single person office do not need to wear a mask, but will be required to wear one when leaving the private work area to move through the healthcare environment e.g. on an errand and when arriving/leaving and if accompanied in the office by others. Administration staff working in healthcare settings (including hospitals, GP surgeries, pharmacy and community settings) are required to wear a face mask. Staff working in multi-occupancy offices should wear masks unless the area has clearly been demonstrated to be COVID-secure, e.g. 2m distancing, frequent environmental surface cleaning, one way movement, adequately ventilated, etc.
