The School Nursing Team are a friendly team based at Le Bas Centre in St Helier. We are part of the Child and Family Division at Family Nursing & Home Care (FNHC).

We provide health services for children aged from 5-19 years. We work in partnership with families, carers and other professionals. Through our work we have identified a need to support families and schools with toilet training children due to start school. We are trialling a new project to help parents understand the importance of their child being 'ready' for the next stage in their education.

Ready for School – Building Blocks to Toilet Training.

The Building Blocks to Toilet Training are 2 consecutive workshops to help you get your child ready for school. These 2 parent workshops which will both take place **at Samares School** whilst your child is in school.

1ST workshop; Thursday 27th May 9.00am - 10.30am

2nd workshop; Wednesday 23rd June 9.00am – 10.30am

We really hope you can join us and take advantage of the support we are offering.

Attending these workshops gives you an opportunity to practice these new skills with your child over the summer ready for their transition to school. We will also be working together with Samares School staff to ensure everyone is following the same plan and giving the same message to your child which will give them the reassurance and confidence to be toilet trained ready for school in September.
