

What we do:

The Community Children's Nurses support children with nursing and health care needs and their families, at home and in the community.

We aim to:

- provide nursing care and support in the home or other community setting, such as a nursery or school
- prevent or reduce hospital admission for children and young people
- provide the family and carers with information, resources and support to promote independence as far as possible
- improve healthcare experiences
- liaison from hospital to home

Nursing Care:

Nursing procedures that we can safely undertake in the community include:

- blood sampling and intravenous drug administration
- wound care and dressings
- stoma care (eg tracheostomy, gastronomy)
- support with injections
- enteral (tube) feeding
- post operative care at home (such as suture removal)

Care Packages:

We will provide support to technology dependent children and children with ongoing complex health needs.

We will work alongside the family to enable the child to be cared for at home and support an agreed health package within the home, if required.

Partnership work:

We work in partnership with families, health care professionals and other statutory and voluntary agencies to:

- Provide holistic care taking into account the needs of the whole family
- Promote quality of care
- Facilitate collaborative care planning between the services involved in the child's or young person's wellbeing
- Support respite and a healthcare package for families
- Support palliative and end-of-life care at home

Support and advice:

We will treat all children as individuals, respecting their needs, cultural and religious beliefs.

Information about the child or young person and their family will normally be shared within the team, and when appropriate, with other members of the multi-discipline team.

Consent will be obtained before the sharing of any information. This will be discussed with the child or young person and their family.

We also take part in the education of healthcare professionals. Families may be asked for their permission for students to accompany the nurse on a visit.

If your child requires feeding, continence or stoma supplies for their ongoing care, you will be provided with a "product voucher" to access these in the community.

The Community Children's Nurses will discuss this process with you.
