

Hospital Patient District Nurse Referrals

If urgent care is required to start on the same day, contact the FNHC DN Hub at adult.referrals@fnhc.org.je or call 01534 497603 (8.30am to 4.30pm Monday to Friday) or out of hours contact DN duty co-ordinator via hospital switchboard to ensure that care is not delayed. Any referrals sent after 5pm may not be seen or activated until the next day.

A reminder **not** to stipulate that a FNHC nurse will visit the next day or every day after discharge. This decision will be made upon acceptance of referral into the community and based on the needs of the patient and the workload placed on the allocated team.

Urinary Catheter

Catheter supplies for 3 full changes including day and night bags. Suggested TWOC date may change depending on Team capacity please inform patient before discharge

All wound dressings

All dressings and associated supplies must be provided for a minimum of 3 dressing changes. This includes suture removal pack/clip removal kit

Medication Chart

Medication chart and /or Authorisation Sheet must be signed (not printed) and sent as an attachment with the referral

Insulin Notice

As much notice as possible must be given when referring a patient for insulin administration. New insulin or changed dose/regime must be reviewed by the diabetic team prior to referral being sent

Continence Products

All continence products must be supplied for 5 days.

Palliative Care

Ensure all paperwork is completed including DNACPR and enough JIC medication is prescribed to allow time for GP to prescribe more

For any medication requirements to start in the community (including IV antibiotics) must be telephoned and discussed prior to discharge
