



The **Rapid Response and Reablement Team** is a hospital admission prevention and early discharge service that provides clinical monitoring, intravenous treatment AND functional physical crisis input in patient's homes. The service consists of nurses, care staff, physiotherapists, occupational therapist and rehabilitation support workers.



Acceptance Criteria Includes

- ✓ Patient has consented to service
- ✓ RRRT Information leaflet has been given to the patient
 - ✓ Aged 18 years or above
 - ✓ Active indefinite DNACPR (if relevant)
 - ✓ Stable NEWS > 24 hours (excluding ED)
- ✓ Improving or stable bloods including infection markers (excluding ED)

Patient requires:

- ✓ IV treatment once/twice daily up to 5 days and has appropriate and viable IV access
- ✓ Requires urgent short term functional support* for home-based care
 - ✓ Up to 7 days input
 - ✓ Clinical assessments
- ✓ Venepuncture / blood results monitoring
 - ✓ Monitoring response to treatment
- ✓ Personal care, cooking, medication admin, mobility issues etc

e.g. *functional impact due to new fracture, uncontrolled pain, fall, UTI, chest infection and acute mobility issues



Please Consider

- ? If the patient does not have capacity who holds the LPA / SROL and have they given consent?
- ? Visitors / residents < 6 months will be charged for the service
- ? Must be registered with Jersey GP and/or Consultant
- ? DNACPR indefinite document must be ready for patients JGH discharge
- ? IVABx need to be approved by microbiologist
- ? Unable to administer IV fluids
- ? Unable to provide acute oxygen (HOOF accepted)
- ? Unable to bridge packages of care
- ? No overnight needs and is safe between visits
